You will see Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church on your right. Go past this, and their football field. Immediately following is All Saints Episcopal, on the right (West) side of Abrams (3617 Abrams). Turn right at All Saints, and find the alley. We have an entrance off the alley, and a sign on the door.
